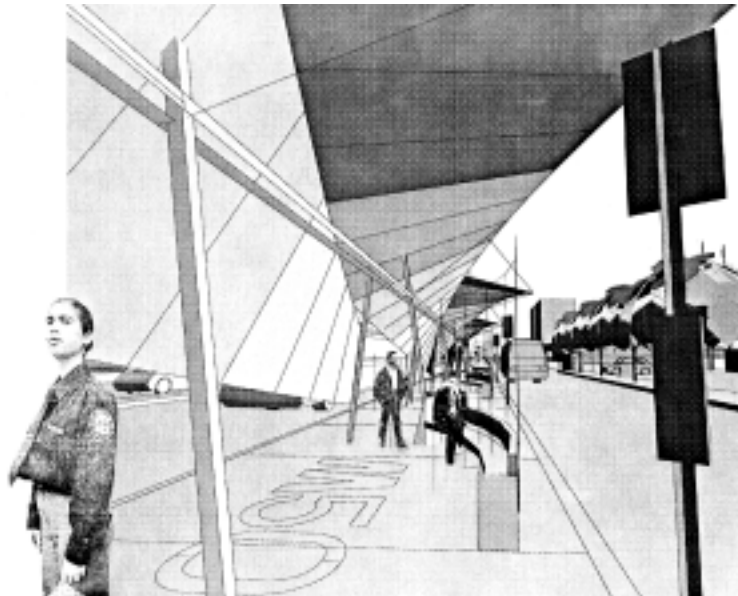


circle line bus station



Four crosstown Manhattan bus lines converge on this proposed station at 42nd Street on the Hudson River, adjacent to the Intrepid Museum and the Circle Line and Weehawken Ferry terminals.

Four curving canvas roofs, determined through computer-extrapolated rotation of a single straight line, are set out in a row as shelters and location markers for the bus stop.

The rolling forms of the station refer to the dynamics of public transport and the maritime surroundings.
